Bio:

LaNia Roberts, born in 1996, resides and works in her hometown of Louisville, Kentucky. Striving to empower marginalized individuals through a fine art career and online social practice, she uses her voice to visually tell the stories of her family, friends, and community. Inspired by Cubism, Fauvism, and Afrofuturism, LaNia channels her experiences into large-scale figurative paintings. Her process involves painting and collaging illustrated bodily elements or "perspectives," into singular compositions that visually translate the complexity of one's identity.

LaNia works to extend her impact through an online-based social practice, inspiring millions worldwide with messages of radical self-compassion, love, and acceptance. Holding a BFA in painting from Syracuse University, LaNia's global studies include researching identity politics and multiculturalism in South Africa, as well as art in Florence, Italy. While in Italy, she interned for Black History Month Florence, expanding her community to many artists across the African Diaspora.

LaNia has been recognized with grants such as the Bill Fischer Award and a Great Meadows Foundation Travel Grant, which enabled her to attend the Venice Biennale in 2022. The 21c Museum Hotels have collected her work, Her artistic practice is represented by the Claire Oliver Gallery in Harlem.
